

**FOR STUDENTS APPLYING FOR AUTOMATION & ROBOTICS (formerly Integrated Manufacturing) TECHNOLOGY DEGREE PROGRAM**

**BEATRICE SNYDER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM  
GUIDELINES FOR PROGRAMS OFFERED AT THE  
ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY CENTER**

**Harold Snyder and his children** have established the Beatrice Snyder Fund for students planning to enroll full-time in the Automation & Robotics Technology degree program offered by Linn State Technical College at the Advanced Technology Center, Mexico, Missouri, or the Computer Information Systems degree program offered by Moberly Area Community College at the Advanced Technology Center. **Students who receive Vocational Rehabilitation or A+ funding may not apply.**

**GENERAL INFORMATION:**

Individual scholarships may be any sum up to \$2500 total. If awarded to a single (one) student this amount is to be paid over a two-semester period: \$1250 each semester. If several awards are made, the committee will determine the individual totals and proper notification will be sent to each affected institution.

Scholarship funds may be used for tuition, fees, books and required supplies. In the event of an award greater than the cost of a semester and the student has paid all fees, a refund may be returned to the student (in the case of scholarships for the Automation & Robotics Technology program, no refunds may be made to the student until proof of payment from both institutions has been received from Linn State Technical College.) Proof of payment information will be the responsibility of a staff member of the Advanced Technology Center.

Once a recipient receives a scholarship, the recipient may continue to apply for additional yearly scholarships provided the recipient is enrolled **full-time** at the Advanced Technology Center and making satisfactory progress toward program completion.

Any student enrolled full-time in either the Computer Information Systems degree program or the Automation & Robotics Technology degree program offered at the Advanced Technology Center may apply, however, candidates from Mexico and Audrain County with a demonstrated need will receive priority consideration.

The scholarship award will be paid directly to either Linn State Technical College or Moberly Area Community College, depending on which school is responsible for the program in which the student is enrolled. Notification of the Computer Information Systems scholarship award will be sent to MACC and notification of the Automation & Robotics Technology scholarship award will be sent to LSTC.

In the event a winner, for any reason, does not enter or continue his/her schooling at the Advanced Technology Center the subsequent semester, he or she shall forfeit all rights to the award. At the discretion of the Beatrice Snyder Scholarship Committee, the remaining money may be given to another student. **If the recipient withdraws or drops classes below the 12 hour minimum, the scholarship will be forfeited and all funds returned to the Beatrice Snyder Scholarship Fund.**

None of the scholarships or awards will involve a disqualified person as defined in Section 4946(a) of the Internal Revenue Code. Basically, the term "disqualified person" includes employees or children of employees of TEVA Pharmaceuticals or children of members who serve on the ATC Advisory Board.

The Beatrice Snyder Scholarship Committee reserves the right from year to year to change the guidelines for the scholarship.

The final decision on the applicants to be selected will rest with the Beatrice Snyder Scholarship Committee.

*If selected, the recipient agrees to send a thank-you letter to the scholarship sponsor. Thank you letters must be submitted to the Foundation Office at Linn State Technical College no later than one month after award is announced.*

#### **PROCEDURE FOR SUBMITTING APPLICATIONS**

1. In this information packet you will find all the materials necessary to participate in the BEATRICE SNYDER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.
2. The applicant should complete the Application.
3. **No later than July 21st**, submit the completed application form to the Advanced Technology Center, 2900 Doreli Lane, Mexico, Missouri 65265 to be forwarded to the Beatrice Snyder Scholarship Committee.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT:**

The scholarship money will be paid directly to Linn State Technical College or Moberly Area Community College, depending on the student's program. Scholarship monies may be deposited with the educational institution prior to the fall semester of each academic year.

All awards are contingent upon enrollment and satisfactory progress in the recipient's program.
