

**FREEDOM CYCLES SCHOLARSHIP  
LINN STATE TECHNICAL COLLEGE  
SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

The scholarship is awarded each year to a student pursuing an Associate of Applied Science degree in Powersports Technology at Linn State Technical College in Linn, Missouri. The \$3,500 scholarship (\$1,750 per year) applies toward costs associated with the student's education, including, but not limited to incidental fees (tuition), books, lab fees, tools, and housing. Selection is based upon meeting the criteria for program admittance. Applicants must reside a minimum of four years in one of the following counties: Jackson, Johnson, Clay, Cass or Platte in the state of Missouri. Application deadline is **February 15**.

**QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS:**

- High School Graduate – GPA 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale, or GED with 260 minimum score.
- Enrolled as a first year full-time student (12 semester credit hours minimum) at Linn State Technical College for the fall semester.

**PROCEDURE FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION:**

Follow the procedures listed below. You will be notified about the status of your application as soon as a decision has been reached.

1. Complete the Linn State Technical College Admissions Application.
2. Forward a copy of your high school and any previous college transcripts.
3. Take the enhanced ACT assessment test as early as possible and request that your scores be sent to Linn State Technical College, or take the COMPASS Test on the LSTC campus.
4. Complete the online Scholarship Application (including personal goal statement).

Deadline for scholarship application is **February 15**. Scholarship consideration is also based on availability of funds.

**SELECTION CRITERIA:**

The criteria used to evaluate applications for award of the scholarship will be based on demonstrated academic performance, leadership and civic/community involvement.

Scholarship Award:

This scholarship is awarded in two installments, \$1,750 each year.

**THE SCHOLARSHIP PROVIDES:**

\$3,500 for tuition, fees, books, tools, and/or other costs associated with the recipient's education. The scholarship award will be paid in two installments directly to the recipient's account at Linn State Technical College. The first installment will be \$1,750 dispersed during the fall semester in the year the scholarship is awarded. The second installment of \$1,750 will be dispersed the second year, first semester, contingent upon the recipient attending classes regularly, maintaining a 3.0 GPA and completing a successful internship at one of the following locations: **Freedom Cycles, Advantage Power Sports, or Warrensburg Cycles.**

**EXPECTATIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT:**

Upon accepting the scholarship, the student agrees to remain enrolled on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 college credit hours), attend classes regularly and maintain a satisfactory academic standing (no less than 3.0 GPA) during the program. In the event the student initially awarded the scholarship is unable to fulfill the requirement of full-time enrollment for the fall semester, the scholarship will be awarded to the next available selection.

Scholarship recipient will intern at Freedom Cycles, Advantage Power Sports or Warrensburg Cycles during the two-year program.

Must contractually agree to work at Freedom Cycles (or Advantage Power Sports or Warrensburg Cycles) for four years following completion of the degree. Failure to complete the contract would require reimbursement of scholarship funds.

Employment after graduation will be solely at the discretion of Freedom Cycles management. The employment contract may be changed or terminated at any time due to employee misconduct.

**RELEASE OF INFORMATION:**

By submitting an application for a scholarship award, authorization is granted by the recipient for release of information contained in the application packet for use by Linn State Technical College and Freedom Cycles in promoting or publicizing the scholarship.

If selected, the recipient agrees to send a thank-you letter to the scholarship sponsor. Thank you letters must be submitted to the Foundation Office at Linn State Technical College no later than one month after award is announced.
