NUCLEAR TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

**GENERAL DESCRIPTION**

Nuclear Suppliers Association awards two \$1,000 scholarships annually to students beginning their second year in Nuclear Technology at Linn State Technical College. Currently enrolled college students in the Nuclear Technology program at the Advanced Technology Center, Mexico, Missouri, are eligible to apply. Selection is based upon demonstrated financial need and academic achievement.

**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- A. Applicant must be enrolled as a full-time, second year Nuclear Technology student (12 hours minimum per semester).
- B. Applicant must demonstrate financial need.
- C. Applicant must attain a 3.0 cumulative GPA during the first two semesters enrolled at Linn State Technical College.
- D. Applicant must demonstrate leadership and effective communication skills through a personal goal statement.

**SELECTION AND AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP**

- A. Selection Criteria. To be considered, applicants must forward a complete application packet, to include letters of recommendation, by the scholarship application deadline. The criteria used to evaluate applications for award will be based equally upon the following:
  - Financial need.
  - Academic achievement
  - Leadership demonstrated through extracurricular involvement or class projects.
  - Ability to communicate clearly defined personal goals through written essay.
- B. Selection Priority. This is a one time, annual scholarship awarded to second year, full-time students enrolled in the Nuclear Technology program at Linn State Technical College. In addition to the designated recipients, a first and second alternate will also be selected. In the event a student is unable to fulfill the requirements of the scholarship, the award will be transferred to the next available alternate.
- C. Scholarship Award. The scholarship provides \$1,000, which is paid directly to the recipient's account at Linn State Technical College in the fall semester upon the student's verified enrollment. The scholarship will apply toward the cost of tuition, fees, books, tools, and/or other costs associated with a student's education.

**APPLICATION PROCEDURES**

Deadline for application to assure consideration is **July 15**. Applicants must follow the procedures outlined below. Applicants will be notified of the status of their application as soon as the scholarship selection committee reaches a decision.

- A. Complete the Linn State Technical College Scholarship Application online ([www.linnstate.edu/admissions/scholarships/apply.php](http://www.linnstate.edu/admissions/scholarships/apply.php)), including personal goal statement.
- B. Submit letters of reference.
- C. Complete necessary financial aid paperwork with the LSTC financial aid office to determine financial need.
- D. Applicant must request a current transcript from the LSTC registrar's office be submitted to the Scholarship committee.

Scholarship consideration is also based on availability of funds.

**EXPECTATIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT**

- A. Upon accepting the scholarship, the student agrees to remain enrolled on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 college credit hours), attend classes regularly, model appropriate behavior and maintain satisfactory academic standing. In the event the student initially awarded the scholarship is unable to fulfill the requirement of full-time enrollment for the fall semester, the scholarship will be awarded to the next available selection.
- B. Release of Information. In submitting application, the applicant or applicant's legal guardian grants authority for release of information contained in the application packet for use by Linn State Technical College in promoting or publicizing the scholarship. If selected, the recipient agrees to participate in ceremonies hosted to honor annual scholarship winners.

If selected, the recipient agrees to send a thank-you letter to the scholarship sponsor. Thank you letters must be submitted to the Foundation Office at Linn State Technical College no later than one month after award is announced.

**To assure consideration, applications must be received by July 15. Linn State Technical College is an equal opportunity organization and encourages applications from all individuals.**
