

**ROBERT V. MARBLE SCHOLARSHIP
LINN STATE TECHNICAL COLLEGE**

This endowed scholarship was established by Gertrude Marshall of Columbia, MO in 1992. The fund supports award of an annual scholarship in the amount of \$750 to youth with troubled backgrounds rehabilitated through the correctional system. Individuals released from the Boonville Correctional Center planning to pursue a certificate of training or degree program as a full-time student at Linn State Technical College are eligible. General provisions of the scholarship are as follows:

QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS:

- Meet minimum admission requirements of Linn State Technical College for the degree or certificate program enrolled.
- Complete high school or GED equivalency.
- Enroll as a full-time student.
- Receive recommendation of Boonville Correctional Center education counselor.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Deadline for application to assure consideration for the next following academic year is **February 15**. Applicants must follow the procedures outlined below. Applicants will be notified of the status of their application as soon as the scholarship selection committee reaches a decision.

- A. Complete the Linn State Technical College Admissions Application.
- B. Forward a copy of your high school transcript or official GED score report.
- C. Take the ACT assessment test as early as possible and request that your scores be sent to Linn State Technical College, or take the COMPASS Test on the LSTC campus.
- D. Complete the online Scholarship Application (including personal goal statement).

- E. Application in letter form indicating: personal history, life experiences and motivation/goals.
- F. Two personal letters of reference and one from the Correctional Center Education Counselor along with any additional documents may be forwarded to:

SCHOLARSHIP PROVIDES:

\$750 school year for tuition, fees, books, tools and related educational expenses. Award will be disbursed to the student's account at Linn State Technical College in an amount of \$375 per semester.

EXPECTATIONS:

Maintain academic standing (2.0 GPA) while enrolled at Linn State Technical College as well as satisfy program requirements to remain in good standing. Recipients must attend classes regularly. In the event the student initially awarded the scholarship is unable to fulfill the

requirement of full-time enrollment for the fall semester, the scholarship will be awarded to the next available selection.

Scholarship will be offered annually. (One student per year.)

If selected, the recipient agrees to send a thank-you letter to the scholarship sponsor. Thank you letters must be submitted to the Foundation Office at Linn State Technical College no later than one month after award is announced.

Deadline for submitting application: February 15
