SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES**

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Awarded each year to a full-time college student enrolled or planning to enroll at Linn State Technical College in pursuit of an associate of applied science degree in Design Drafting Technology or Industrial Electricity. The scholarship has two award opportunities. Students who reside in the St. Louis area will receive priority consideration.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Applicant should be enrolled as a full-time student (12 hours minimum per semester).
- B. Applicant should enroll the fall semester as a full-time student. Second year students may also apply for a one year scholarship.
- C. Applicant should be a citizen of the United States.
- D. Applicant should be student in good academic standing with a minimum 2.5 college or high school cumulative GPA, or GED score must be 260 or above.

SELECTION AND AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

- A. Selection Criteria. To be considered, applicants must forward a complete application packet, to include letters of recommendation, by the scholarship application deadline. The criteria used to evaluate applications for award will be based equally upon the following:
 - Financial need.
 - Academic achievement.
 - Civic involvement through school and community.
 - Leadership demonstrated through extracurricular involvement.
 - Availability to intern at Roeslein during summer semester.
- B. Selection Priority. Priority will be given to applicants pursuing a certificate or associate of applied science degree in Design Drafting Technology with financial need. This is a one time, annual scholarship awarded to full time students attending Linn State Technical College. In the event a student is unable to fulfill the requirement of full-time enrollment for the fall semester in the year the scholarship is awarded, the scholarship will be transferred to the next available alternate.
- C. Scholarship Award. The scholarship provides \$2,250 during the first year. Upon maintaining eligibility, students may qualify for an additional \$2,250 during the second year of the program. For students receiving the award during the second year only, \$2,250 is the maximum scholarship award. The scholarship award will be credited to the recipient's account at Linn State Technical College. The scholarship will apply toward the cost of tuition, fees, books, tools, and/or other costs associated with a student's education.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Deadline for application to assure consideration for the academic year is **February 15**. Applicants must follow the procedures outlined below. Applicants will be notified of the status of their application as soon as the scholarship selection committee reaches a decision.

- A. Complete the Linn State Technical College Admissions Application.
- B. Forward a copy of your high school transcript or official GED score report.
- C. Take the ACT assessment test as early as possible and request that your scores be sent to Linn State Technical College, or take the COMPASS Test on the LSTC campus.
- D. Complete the online Scholarship Application (including personal goal statement).

- E. Three letters of reference and any additional documents may be forwarded to:

Scholarship consideration is also based on availability of funds.

EXPECTATIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

- A. Upon accepting the scholarship, the student agrees to remain enrolled on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 college credit hours), attend classes regularly, model appropriate behavior and maintain satisfactory academic standing. In the event the student initially awarded the scholarship is unable to fulfill the requirement of full-time enrollment for the fall semester, the scholarship will be awarded to the next available selection.
- B. Release of Information. In submitting application, the applicant or applicant's legal guardian grants authority for release of information contained in the application packet for use by Linn State Technical College and the Roeslein & Associates, Inc. in promoting or publicizing the scholarship. If selected, the recipient agrees to participate in ceremonies hosted to honor annual scholarship winners.
- C. To qualify for the second year award, students must maintain full-time status with the college, maintain a 3.0 GPA, attend classes regularly, and participate in an internship at Roeslein & Associates, Inc.

If selected, the recipient agrees to send a thank-you letter to the scholarship sponsor. Thank you letters must be submitted to the Foundation Office at Linn State Technical College no later than one month after award is announced.

To assure consideration, applications must be received by the deadline. Linn State Technical College is an equal opportunity organization and encourages applications from all individuals.
