

**YEAGER'S CYCLE SALES
LINN STATE TECHNICAL COLLEGE
SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

The scholarship is awarded every other year to a student pursuing an Associate of Applied Science degree in Powersports Technology at Linn State Technical College in Linn, Missouri. The \$2,000 scholarship applies toward costs associated with the student's education, including, but not limited to incidental fees (tuition), books, lab fees, tools, and housing. Selection is based upon meeting the criteria for program admittance. Preference will be given to applicants residing in the Yeager's Cycle Sales territory. Application deadline is **February 15**.

QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS

- A. High School Graduate – GPA 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale, or GED with 260 minimum score.
- B. Enrolled as a first year full-time student (12 semester credit hours minimum) at Linn State Technical College for the fall semester.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

Follow the procedures listed below. You will be notified about the status of your application as soon as a decision has been reached by the scholarship committee.

- A. Complete the Linn State Technical College Admissions Application.
- B. Forward a copy of your high school and any previous college transcripts.
- C. Take the enhanced ACT assessment test as early as possible and request that your scores be sent to Linn State Technical College, or take the COMPASS Test on the LSTC campus.
- D. Complete the online Scholarship Application (including personal goal statement).

- E. Two letters of recommendation and any additional documents may be forwarded to:

Deadline for scholarship application is **February 15**. Scholarship application must be signed by the applicant. Scholarship consideration is also based on availability of funds.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The criteria used to evaluate applications for award of the scholarship will be based on demonstrated academic performance, leadership and civic/community involvement.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

This scholarship is awarded in two installments. The scholarship provides: \$2,000 for tuition, fees, books, tools, and/or other costs associated with the recipient's education. The scholarship award will be paid in two installments directly to the recipient's account at Linn State Technical College. The first installment will be \$1,000 dispersed during the fall semester in the year the scholarship is awarded. The second installment will be dispersed the second year, first semester contingent upon the recipient attending classes regularly, maintaining a 2.5 GPA and completing a successful internship with Yeager's Cycle Sales.

EXPECTATIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

Upon accepting the scholarship, the student agrees to remain enrolled on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 college credit hours), attend classes regularly and maintain a satisfactory academic standing (no less than 2.5 GPA) during the program. In the event the student initially awarded the scholarship is unable to fulfill the requirement of the full-time enrollment for the fall semester, the scholarship will be awarded to the next available selection.

Scholarship recipient will intern at Yeager's Cycle Sales during the two-year program.

The scholarship recipient must contractually agree to work at Yeager's Cycle Sales for four years following completion of the degree. Failure to complete the contract would mean reimbursement of scholarship based on incomplete term.

Employment after graduation will be solely at the discretion of Yeager's Cycle Sales management. The employment contract may be changed or terminated at any time due to employee misconduct or if a position is not available.

RELEASE OF INFORMATION:

By submitting an application for a scholarship award, authorization is granted by the recipient for release of information contained in the application packet for use by Linn State Technical College and Yeager's Cycle Sales in promoting or publicizing the scholarship.

If selected, the recipient agrees to send a thank-you letter to the scholarship sponsor. Thank you letters must be submitted to the Foundation Office at Linn State Technical College no later than one month after award is announced.
