During Dr. Ted Gasper's tenure at Linn Tech, the Nilges Administration Building was completed on the main campus giving the campus a whole new look.

In a previous interview, Gasper stated the resourceful nature of the faculty and staff were exhibited in the design and construction of the building. "The faculty and staff were constantly seeking new and better ways to deliver better education," he said. "Not being part of either the university system or the community college system, the college was on their own."

Also during Gasper's tenure at Linn Tech, then-Governor John Ashcroft signed a bill granting state statutory authority to Missouri's only technical college to grant associate degrees. Gasper points with pride to a major computer hardware and software upgrade as well.

Gasper left Linn Tech to become president of Montgomery Community College in North Carolina. Gasper now resides in North Carolina.
