



Linn State Technical College Admissions Testing Procedures

Student calls to schedule test.

Did the student request accommodations?

NO

Give test under regular conditions.
Admissions staff will conduct testing.

YES

Admissions Counselor receives caller's information. Does student present recent (within 5 years) adult-level documentation? Including, but not limited to:

Aptitude/Information Processing

- Wechsler Adult Intelligence Scale-Revised (WAIS-R)
- Woodcock Johnson Psycho Educational Battery Revised: Tests of Cognitive Ability
- Stanford Binet Intelligence Scale: Fourth Edition

Achievement Testing:

- Woodcock Johnson Psycho Educational Revised: Tests of Achievement
- Wechsler Individual Achievement Test (WIAT)
- Stanford Test of Academic Skills (TASK)
- Scholastic Abilities Test for Adults (SATA)
- Specific achievement tests such as Test of Written Language-2 (TOWL-2), Woodcock Reading Mastery Tests Revised; or the Stanford Diagnostic Mathematics Test

Student will also need to submit High School IEP & Transition Plan, 504 Accommodation Plan, and Diagnostic Summaries.

NO

Admissions Counselor reviews documentation. Consults with LEA, VRE, and/or Counselor as needed.

NO

Admissions Counselor contacts tester to request additional documentation or to decline accommodations request. Student may take test without accommodations.

Give accommodated test. Admissions Counselor conducts testing.
