**Linn Technical College
Aviation Club
Constitution**

- Article I NAME
- Section I The name of this Club shall be the Linn Technical College Aviation Club.
- Article II PURPOSE
- Section I The purpose of this club will be to:
- A. Stimulate an interest in Aviation
 - B. Improve a members knowledge of:
 - (1) Aviation
 - (2) Aviation History
 - (3) Interact with other Aviation organizations
- Article III MEANS
- Section I The means by which the club shall be by:
- A. Meetings for presentation and discussion of educational subjects relating to Aviation.
 - B. Field-days and field trips
 - C. Operation on a non-profit and non-incorporated basis
 - D. Social activities
- Article IV MEMBERSHIP
- Section I Club membership is open to anyone showing a sufficient interest in Aviation.
- Article V DISMISSAL
- Section I Any member of officer is subject to dismissal from the club for any of the following reasons:
- A. Failure to perform his duties of office in a reasonable manner.
 - B. As a result of advisory committee action.
- Article VI SPONSOR
- Section I The club will have a sponsor who shall be a Linn Technical College Faculty Member.
- A. He shall advise and counsel members as needed for proper club functioning.
 - B. He can aid the club members in giving technical assistance as needed.

Article VII

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS

Section I

- A. Any club member desiring to propose an amendment to this constitution may do so by securing the signatures of 1/3 of the club members (in good standing at time of proposal and presenting to the advisory committee for review before presentation at a business meeting).**
- B. The amendment will be announced at two consecutive business meetings and a copy of same given to all members.**
- C. The amendment will be voted on at the 3rd meeting and must have a 2/3 majority vote for adoption to the constitution.**

Article VIII

BY-LAWS

Section I

The by-laws will be reviewed by the new officers and members of the club each year, and changed, (if necessary) by the approval of 2/3 vote.

- A. Changes to the by-laws will be done as constitutional amendments: Article VII, Section A,B,C.**
